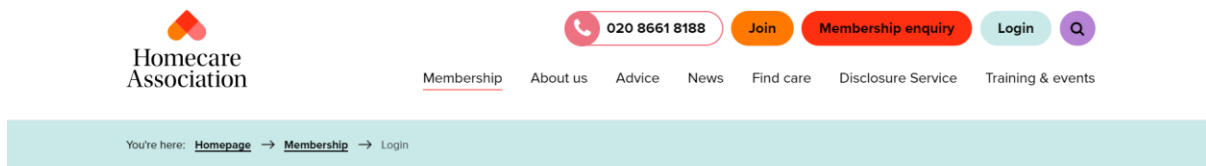

First Time Login

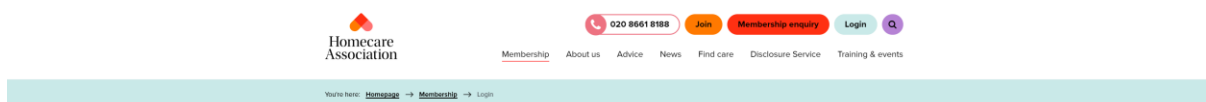
1. Go to the login page on our main website: [Login \(homecareassociation.org.uk\)](https://homecareassociation.org.uk)
